

## **Boarding responsibilities**

### VETERINARY AND HEALTH CARE

If your pet needs to have tablets or other medication administered we can arrange to do this for you. However if your pet requires a lot of medical care, please consult us before booking.

If your pet becomes ill whilst at our premises we will contact you on the telephone numbers you have provided, we will always need an emergency number. If we cannot contact you, your pet will be taken to the vets and your account will be charged accordingly.

### ELDERLY AND FRAIL ANIMALS

If you plan on boarding a very old or frail animal, please consult us before you book. We would remind our customers that regretfully we will have to refuse to accommodate any animal which appears to be in an unsuitable condition for boarding. This applies to temperament as well as health.

### VACCINATIONS

All registered kennels are required by law to ensure that the animals boarded are fully vaccinated. We will need to see proof of vaccination card on arrival.

DOGS need to be vaccinated for;

Distemper, Hepatitis, Leptospirosis and Parvovirus.

We also strongly recommend immunisation for kennel cough- PLEASE NOTE: THIS MUST BE DONE AT LEAST 2 WEEKS BEFORE BOARDING IF YOU CHOOSE TO HAVE THE VACCINATION.

CATS need to be vaccinated for;

Feline Enteritis and Cat Flu
